NORTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

FARGO, ND, April 21, 2014 – Milk production in North Dakota for the January – March 2014 quarter totaled 81 million pounds, down 8 percent from 88 million pounds during the same period a year earlier, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 17,000 head.
