NORTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

FARGO, ND, November 1, 2013 – Milk production in North Dakota for the July – September 2013 quarter totaled 84 million pounds, down 2 percent from 86 million pounds during the same period a year earlier, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows, at 17,500 head, was down 500 head from the July-September 2012 quarter.
