NORTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

FARGO, ND, October 20, 2014 – Milk production in North Dakota during the July – September 2014 quarter totaled 79 million pounds, down six percent from 84 million pounds during the same period a year earlier, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 16,000 head.
