NORTH DAKOTA COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE ON FARMS

FARGO, ND, August 20, 2013 -- According to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, 77 percent of North Dakota farms had access to computers in 2013. This compares to the national average of 70 percent. Seventy-three percent of farms in North Dakota had internet access, up 6 percent from the last time this data was collected in 2011.
