August Milk Production

Dairy herds in Ohio produced 474 million pounds of milk during August, up 3.5 percent from a year ago, according to Cheryl Turner, State Statistician of the USDA, NASS, Ohio Field Office. Production per cow in Ohio averaged 1,865 pounds for August, 35 pounds above August 2019. The dairy herd was estimated at 254,000 head for August, up 4,000 head from a year earlier.

Milk production in the 24 major States during August totaled 17.8 billion pounds, up 1.9 percent from August 2019. July revised production, at 17.9 billion pounds, was up 2.0 percent from July 2019. The July revision represented an increase of 91 million pounds or 0.5 percent from last month's preliminary production estimate. Production per cow in the 24 major States averaged 2,009 pounds for August, 25 pounds above August 2019. The number of milk cows on farms in the 24 major States was 8.84 million head, 51,000 head more than August 2019, but unchanged from July 2020.
