Ohio Winter Wheat Production

Winter wheat growers in Ohio expect a slightly decreased yield this year, dropping 1 bushel from 2014, according to Cheryl Turner, State Statistician of the USDA, NASS, Ohio Field Office. Ohio wheat growers expect to harvest 530,000 acres, down 15,000 acres from last year. Wheat production in the State is expected to be 38.7 million bushels. Winter wheat yield is expected to be 73 bushels per acre.

Nationally, winter wheat production is forecast at 1.51 billion bushels, up 2 percent from the May 1 forecast and up 9 percent from 2014. Based on June 1 conditions, the United States yield is forecast at 44.5 bushels per acre, up 1 bushel from last month and up 1.9 bushels from last year.
