**Monthly Summary for January 2021**

**Issued January 25, 2021**

According to the January 19, US Drought Monitor Report, 32 percent of the state was in the moderate to exceptional drought categories, up 12 points from the previous year. Just 12 percent of the state was in the moderate to exceptional drought categories, compared to 9 percent from the previous year. Topsoil and subsoil moisture conditions were rated mostly adequate to short.

**Small Grains:** Winter wheat grazed reached 51 percent. Rye grazed reached 22 percent. Oats grazed reached 28 percent.

**Pasture and Livestock:** Pasture and range condition was rated at 74 percent good to fair. Livestock condition was rated at 86 percent good to fair.
