Rainfall totals in Oklahoma averaged 0.56 of an inch. According to the February 22nd US Drought Monitor Report, drought conditions were rated 93 percent abnormally dry to exceptional drought, down 5 percent from the previous week. Additionally, 87 percent of the state was in the moderate drought to exceptional drought category, down 1 percent from the previous week. Statewide, temperatures averaged in the high 20's. Topsoil and subsoil moisture conditions were rated mostly very short to short. There were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork.

Small Grains: Winter wheat grazed reached 66 percent, up 16 points from the previous year. Rye grazed reached 50 percent, up 19 points from the previous year and down 1 point from normal. Oats grazed reached 50 percent, up 11 points from the previous year and up 7 points from normal.

Pasture and Livestock: Pasture and range condition was rated at 62 percent fair to poor. Livestock condition was rated at 84 percent fair to good.
