Rainfall totals in Oklahoma averaged 0.35 of an inch. According to the November 8th US Drought Monitor Report, drought conditions were rated 100 percent abnormally dry to exceptional drought, unchanged from the previous week. Additionally, 98 percent of the state was in the moderate drought to exceptional drought categories, down 2 points from the previous week. Statewide, temperatures averaged in the low 50's. Topsoil and subsoil moisture conditions were rated mostly very short to short. There were 5.9 days suitable for fieldwork.

Small Grains: Winter wheat planted reached 95 percent, up 2 points from the previous year and up 2 points from normal. Winter wheat emerged reached 82 percent, up 1 point from the previous year but down 1 point from normal. Canola planted reached 90 percent, up 1 point from the previous year and up 3 points from normal. Canola emerged reached 67 percent, up 1 point from the previous year but down 2 points from normal. Rye planted reached 95 percent, unchanged from the previous year but up 1 point from normal. Rye emerged reached 75 percent, down 5 points from the previous year and down 2 points from normal. Oats planted reached 65 percent, up 6 points from the previous year and up 8 points from normal. Oats emerged reached 10 percent.

Row Crops: Sorghum harvested reached 92 percent, up 8 points from the previous year and up 11 points from normal. Soybeans harvested reached 70 percent, up 1 point from the previous year and up 5 points from normal. Peanuts harvested reached 85 percent, up 6 points from the previous year and up 7 points from normal. Cotton harvested reached 61 percent, up 2 points from the previous year and up 11 points from normal.

Hay: The fifth cutting of alfalfa hay reached 60 percent, up 11 points from the previous year and up 5 points from the previous week. The fourth cutting of other hay reached 55 percent, up 22 points from the previous year and up 5 points from the previous week.

Pasture and Livestock: Pasture and range condition was rated at 82 percent very poor to poor. Livestock condition was rated at 74 percent fair to good.

Weather for Week Ending: Temperatures ranged from 12 degrees at Hooker on Saturday, November 12th to 82 degrees at Stillwater, Sallisaw, Waurika, and Wister on Wednesday, November 9th. Precipitation ranged from 0.01 of an inch in the Panhandle district to 1.07 inches in the Northeast district. Soil temperature averages ranged from 41 degrees at Foraker and Newkirk on Sunday, November 13th, to 70 degrees at Burneyville on Wednesday, November 9th.
