Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.73 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 4, down slightly from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 4, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 11 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 4, was 5.08 million, up 28 percent from the previous week, and up 19 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 4, was 11.6 million, down 9 percent from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.
