**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.61 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 11, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 2 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 11, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 6 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 11, was 4.92 million, down 3 percent from the previous week, and up 6 percent from the previous year.
