Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.80 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 9, up slightly from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 9, was 4.11 million, down 6 percent from the previous week, and down 11 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 9, up slightly from the week prior and up 5 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 9, was 12.8 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
