Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.84 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 16, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 16, was 3.14 million, down 24 percent from the previous week, and down 9 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 16, down 2 percent from the week prior and up 5 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 16, was 12.6 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and up 6 percent from the previous year.
