Cooperating with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry

Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.49 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 30, down 3 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 30, was 4.94 million, up 7 percent from the previous week, and up 25 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 30, up slightly from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 30, was 12.8 million, down slightly from the previous week and up 11 percent from the previous year.
