**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.68 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 6, up 3 percent from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 6, was 5.34 million, up 8 percent from the previous week, and up 7 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 6, down slightly from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 6, was 12.8 million, down slightly from the previous week and up 11 percent from the previous year.
