Cooperating with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry

Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.67 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 13, down slightly from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 13, was 4.62 million, down 13 percent from the previous week, and down 15 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 13, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 2 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 13, was 12.4 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
