Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.72 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 4, up 1 percent from the week prior and up slightly from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 4, down 1 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 4, was 4.14 million, down 10 percent from the previous week, and up 37 percent from the previous year.
