Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.70 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 25, down 1 percent from the week prior and down slightly from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 25, was 3.71 million, down 27 percent from the previous week, but up 21 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 14.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 25, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 25, was 12.5 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 6 percent from the previous year.
