Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.82 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 26, up slightly from the week prior and 3 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 13.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 26, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 4 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 26, was 4.32 million, down 8 percent from the previous week but up 6 percent from the previous year.
