**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.73 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 8, up slightly from the week prior and 2 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 13.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 8, down 6 percent from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 8, was 4.16 million, down 25 percent from the previous week but up 20 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 8, was 11.3 million, up 4 percent from the previous week but down 2 percent from the previous year.
