Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.58 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 7, down 4 percent from the week prior and 3 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 7, was 4.21 million, up 8 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 7, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 7, was 12.7 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 1 percent from the previous year.
