**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.44 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 21, down 6 percent from the week prior and 3 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 21, was 3.44 million, down 18 percent from the previous week and down 26 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 21, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 21, was 12.9 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 1 percent from the previous year.
