Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.58 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 28, up 2 percent from the week prior and 1 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 28, was 3.53 million, up 3 percent from the previous week, but down 29 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 28, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 28, was 12.8 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down slightly from the previous year.
