**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.32 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 27, down 3 percent from the week prior, but 13 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 27, up 6 percent from the week prior and up 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 27, was 3.92 million, up 8 percent from the previous week, but down 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 27, was 12.7 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 5 percent from the previous year.
