



Weekly Broiler Report

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Cooperating with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry and Texas Department of Agriculture

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Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.36 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 15, up 11 percent from the week prior and 13 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 15, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 12 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 15, was 4.53 million, down 9 percent from the previous week, but up 36 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 15, was 12.8 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 12 percent from the previous year.
