Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.51 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 8, down 3 percent from the week prior and 3 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 8, up 3 percent from the week prior and up 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 8, was 3.49 million, down 20 percent from the previous week and down 25 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 8, was 13.8 million, down 6 percent from the previous week, but up 2 percent from the previous year.
