Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.20 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 21, down 6 percent from the week prior and 6 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 21, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 21, was 4.09 million, down 21 percent from the previous week and down 13 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 21, was 14.1 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 1 percent from the previous year.
