**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.52 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 4, down 4 percent from the week prior, but 3 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 17.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 4, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 4, was 4.32 million, up 23 percent from the previous week, but down 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 4, was 13.9 million, down slightly from the previous week and down 2 percent from the previous year.
