Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.70 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 18, up 3 percent from the week prior, but 14 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 18, up 3 percent from the week prior, but down 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 18, was 4.35 million, up 31 percent from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 18, was 13.8 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 2 percent from the previous year.
