Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.07 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 8, down 1 percent from the week prior and 1 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 8, up slightly from the week prior, but down 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 8, was 3.15 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 8, was 13.8 million, down slightly from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
