Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.75 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 4, up 3 percent from the week prior and 1 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 4, down slightly from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 4, was 3.68 million, down 12 percent from the previous week and down 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 4, was 13.0 million, up 9 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
