Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.55 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 16, down 2 percent from the week prior and 4 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 16, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 16, was 5.00 million, up 7 percent from the previous week and up 27 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 16, was 13.2 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
