Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.54 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 23, down slightly from the week prior and 4 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 23, was 4.58 million, down 8 percent from the previous week, but up 16 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 23, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 23, was 13.7 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
