Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.89 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 16, up 4 percent from the week prior and 10 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 16, up slightly from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 16, was 3.55 million, down 5 percent from the previous week and down 11 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 16, was 13.8 million, down slightly from the previous week but up 5 percent from the previous year.
