Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.99 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 27, up 3 percent from the week prior and 3 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 27, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 27, was 4.22 million, up 21 percent from the previous week and up 83 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 27, was 14.2 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 6 percent from the previous year.
