Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.68 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 1, up 2 percent from the week prior, but 1 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 1, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 1, was 3.80 million, down 15 percent from the previous week and down 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 1, was 14.2 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 7 percent from the previous year.
