Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.64 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 8, down 1 percent from the week prior and 3 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 8, was 3.82 million, up slightly from the previous week, but down 20 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 8, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 8, was 14.1 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 5 percent from the previous year.
