Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.57 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 30, down 2 percent from the week prior and 1 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 30, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 30, was 5.02 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 14 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 30, was 13.2 million, down 6 percent from the previous week but up 2 percent from the previous year.
