**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.20 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 7, down 5 percent from the week prior and 5 percent below the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 18.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 7, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 18 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 7, was 4.42 million, down 12 percent from the previous week and down 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 7, was 13.9 million, up 6 percent from the previous week and up 8 percent from the previous year.
