

The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of June. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on September 30, 2019.

Oklahoma stocks of wheat in all positions on June 1 totaled 86.4 million bushels, down 20 percent from the 2018 level of 109 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 85.0 million bushels, are 20 percent lower than a year ago.


Texas stocks of wheat in all positions on June 1, at 55.0 million bushels, are down 30 percent from the 2018 level of 79.0 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 54.2 million bushels, are 31 percent lower than a year ago.

All Positions




Texas off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 18.3 million bushels. On-farm stocks for sorghum totaled 200 thousand bushels on June 1, 2019. **Texas** off-farm corn stocks, at 39.8 million bushels, are down 23 percent from last year. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

Oklahoma off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 3.33 million bushels, up 4 percent June 1, 2018. On-farm stocks for sorghum are not published for the state. **Oklahoma** off-farm corn stocks, at 7.84 million bushels, are down 8 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

U.S. Highlights: Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 2019 totaled 5.20 billion bushels, 2 percent lower than June 1, 2018. All wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 2019 totaled 1.07 billion bushels in all positions, down 2 percent from a year ago. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 115 million bushels, 75 percent above June 1, 2018. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 1.79 billion bushels, up 47 percent from last year.
