Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.60 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 4, down 2 percent from the week prior, but up slightly from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 4, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 22 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 4, was 3.48 million, down 20 percent from the previous week and 26 percent below from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 4, was 14.7 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up 26 percent from the previous year.
