Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.41 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 29, up slightly from the week prior, but 1 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 29, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 29, was 4.25 million, down 2 percent from the previous week, but up 30 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 29, was 14.2 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.
