Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.36 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 7, down 1 percent from the week prior and 3 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 7, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 7, was 4.07 million, down 4 percent from the previous week, but up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 7, was 13.2 million, down 7 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.
