Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.82 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 28, up 9 percent from the week prior and slightly above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 28, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 28, was 3.50 million, down 15 percent from the previous week and down 12 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 28, was 13.9 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up slightly from the previous year.
