Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.75 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 16, down 1 percent from the week prior and 15 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 16, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 16, was 4.29 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and down 16 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 16, was 12.7 million, down 9 percent from the previous week and down 13 percent from the previous year.
