Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.87 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 18, down 6 percent from the week prior and 10 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 18, up 1 percent from the week prior, but down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 18, was 3.35 million, down 36 percent from the previous week and down 40 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 18, was 14.8 million, down 6 percent from the previous week, but up 6 percent from the previous year.
