Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.45 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 10, up 2 percent from the week prior and 4 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 10, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 10, was 3.11 million, down 18 percent from the previous week and down 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 10, was 13.4 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and down 4 percent from the previous year.
