Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.51 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 5, down 6 percent from the week prior and 10 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 5, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 5, was 4.40 million, up 3 percent from the previous week, but down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 5, was 14.4 million, up 5 percent from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.
