Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.50 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 27, up 14 percent from the week prior but down 1 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 27, up 16 percent from the week prior but down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 27, was 4.34 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 25 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 27, was 14.9 million, up 6 percent from the previous week and up 1 percent from the previous year.
