Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.63 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 23, up slightly from the week prior and slightly above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 23, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 23, was 5.21 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 29 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 23, was 14.8 million, down slightly from the previous week and slightly above the previous year.
